Recyclables accepted and conditions for each group

Plastic milk jugs

- * Remove lids
- * Rinse with cold water
- * Labels need not be removed

Newspapers and magazines

- * Newspaper (inserts can stay in paper)
- * All glossy magazines and coupons
- * Small catalogues
- * Must be clean and dry with ties removed – no plastic

Oil

- * Oil filters
- * Oil jugs
- * Used oil

Mixed office paper

- * Printed white and colored papers
- * Coated and uncoated papers
- * Manilla file folders
- * Copy paper
- * Envelopes
- * Junk mail – no plastics
- * Computer paper

Tin cans

- * Clean
- * Top lid placed inside
- * Bottom lid need not be removed
- * Lids from glass jars

Glass

- * Any and all types of glass
- * Clean and remove lids and labels
- * No hazardous product containers

Plastics

- * Any and all types
- * Remove lids and labels
- * Rinse in cold water
- * Flatten
- * No hazardous product containers
- * Plastic bags

Cardboard and boxboard

- * Corrugated boxes flattened
- * Cereal boxes, food boxes, toy boxes (remove plastic liner)
- * Kleenex boxes
- * Paper rolls
- * Construction paper
- * Brown paper bags
- * Must be clean and dry with ties removed – no plastic

Products not accepted at this time

- * Waxed cardboard boxes
- * Styrofoam
- * Kleenex or hand towels

- * Carbon paper
- * Paint cans
- * Varsol cans
- * Foil
- * Aerosol cans

- * Plastic laminated paper
- * Plastic twine
- * Silage bags

Recyclables must be separated and placed in proper bins
