Socioeconomic Contributions

EY's report found that, as a community partner, the Grassy Mountain Project will make a range of broader socioeconomic contributions, including:



Strengthening local communities and entrepreneurial ecosystems

Including job creation, support for community programs, and investment in local business development.



Enabling Indigenous economic participation and capacity building

Creating employment, procurement, and training opportunities for First Nations communities.



Contributing to Canada's trade position and supporting regional growth

Helping strengthen Canada's trade balance and supporting growth across downstream supply chains.



Economic impact assessment results

The Grassy Mountain Project will provide economic contributions to Canada, Alberta and southern Alberta. Including:
